An 'Iron Chef' Noodles Around

Masaharu Morimoto, the culinary personality of "Iron Chef" fame, is going into the ramen business.

Mr. Morimoto is opening Momosan Ramen & Sake on Friday. The Murray Hill restaurant will offer a few varieties of the noodle soup, including a Malaysian-inspired tan tan ramen with coconut curry (\$11-\$14) and a Tokyo chicken ramen (\$10-13). Also on the bill: appetizers such as Peking duck tacos (\$5 per taco) and chashu salad with pork (\$12). Lunch will also be offered starting Monday.

True to its name, Momosan Ramen & Sake will also offer sakes by the glass, along with sake-based cocktails and other alcoholic beverages.
